Answer. Question?
Speaking version

This is a quick fun game!

1. Divide the group into 2 or just have each child get their own turn.
2. Explain to the group that you're going to say an answer (from the list below) such as:
"Fine, thanks!"

They have to ask a question that can fit perfectly with the question such as:
"How are you?"
3. It gets tricky when the answer is:
"To the store."
"Where are you?" doesn't work because "at the store" would be the response to that. A correct question to fit, "to the store" would be "Where are you going?"

The fact that it gets technical is what makes it fun! The children will shout a question that doesn't work. When you smile and shake your head no, they'll often laugh in their attempt to try again.
4. Go around the room 1-2 times or until the allotted time runs out!
