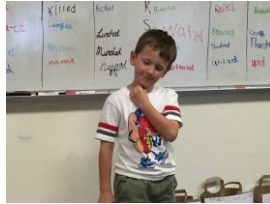




## Describe. Guess.

This is a great game to play the last few minutes of a lesson or day. It engages and quiets a group every time.

1. One student stands at the front of the group.



2. He/she describes something that coincides with the topic discussed (a place, a person, movie, brand name etc.)
3. The student has to say at least 3 sentences about the word before volunteers can guess what the word is.
4. The student chooses another student who is seated, quiet and has his/her hand up to guess.



5. Whichever student guesses correctly, takes the next turn.
6. Continue play until everyone has had a turn or the allotted time runs out!
