

## Descriptive Scene A-Z adjectives list

- 1. Write the letters A to Z vertically in 4-5 columns on a whiteboard.
- 2. Explain to the children that they have to write one word for each letter of the alphabet. Each word has to be a word that can describe a scene. This can include weather and how a scene looks, sounds, smells or feels.
- 3. Fill 2-3 letters with examples to get them started.
- 4. The list below gives ideas in case there is a letter the students can't fill.
