To write a date correctly, you have to capitalize the first letter of the month. Then, you write the number of the day and a comma. Last, you write the year. The year has 4 digits. Look at this example:

April 15, 2020

The short way to write a date is to use only numbers. Look at this example:

4-15-2020

The 4 stands for the 4th month (April). The 15 stands for the 15th day. 2020 tells us which year. Look at the following dates written in number form. Write each date in word form. For example:

4-15-2020 → April 15, 2020
